

Adding New Fonts

There are lots of free fonts you can download and install on your mac to use in multiple applications, including Pages, Keynote, and Word. Use this guide to learn the process of adding new fonts.

-First, go to dafont.com and browse for fonts.

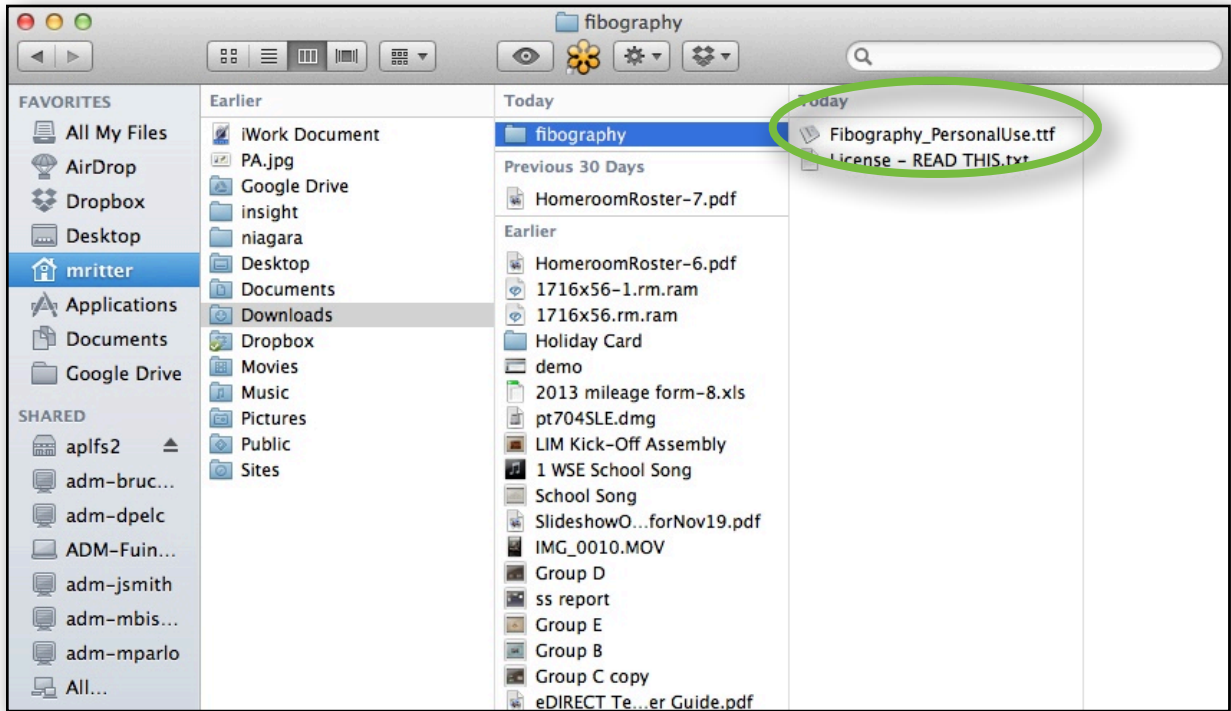
-The font styles are listed across the top. When you select one you are taken to a group that matches that style.

-Once installed, when you open Pages or another word processor, you will see your new font available for you to use in your documents.
