

# Using the App Switcher

OS X includes a built-in application switcher for moving between any open applications quickly. To access the App Switcher, hold down the Command Key and press Tab.



Continue holding the Command key to keep the App Switcher active. Each open application will be represented by its icon. To switch to another application, keep holding Command and press Tab until the desired app is highlighted. Then release the keys.

To quit an application from the App Switcher, keep holding Command while tabbing over to the desired application's icon. While still holding Command, press Q to quit the highlighted application.
